IYT Small Powerboat & RIB Master Certificate

The Small Powerboat & Rib Master course will introduce students to the basics of small powerboats, dinghies and rigid inflatable boats (RIB), rules of the road, safety at sea, navigation and weather basics, engine checks, boat maintenance, close quarters and high speed maneuvering skills and much more.

The objective of the course is to develop the skills and gain the knowledge to safely handle small boats and dinghies. Whether simply spending a day out in sheltered waters or crossing an ocean, there is no substitute for safety awareness, common sense and a solid foundation of maritime knowledge.

Your training will be completed on a 26ft Dual 200hp Outboard powered RIB that is built for the ocean. Other schools, you use a 40hp, single outboard RIB which limits your learning potential!

IYT VHF Radio Operators Certificate

Communications at sea is of vital importance to ensure the safety of all who use the oceans. The ability to call for help when needed is the most important function of a VHF or SSB radio.

At a minimum, all crew members should be instructed in VHF operating procedures and be able to operate a VHF Radio in the event of an emergency.

Most countries require anyone with a transmitting device, such as a VHF Radio, have a Radio Operators License to operate it.

Good communications while at sea are necessary for a number of different applications: Safety, Operational & Business, Ship to Ship and Ship to Shore.

Familiarity with and the correct use of the various communications equipment on board is essential and sometime compulsory.
